Swimming Pool Rules

Pool Hours 10:00 AM - 9:00 PM, 7 days a week during pool season

Admission

Only homeowners in good standing and their invited guests are permitted to use the pool, during approved pool hours of operation. Identification in the form of pool tags or other means may be required for entry.

Attire

Homeowners and guests should dress in attire befitting the family nature of our Community. Extremely revealing attire, such as a thong, is not suitable for the family atmosphere of the pool.

Authority

These rules and regulations are designed to ensure the enjoyment and safety of swimmers. Parents are ultimately responsible for their child's safety. The HOA and its designated representatives shall have the authority to remove anyone from the pool area that is not abiding by the rules.

The Board and Association reserve the right to deny access to the pools to anyone for any reason at any point in time.

Balls and Other Recreational Objects

- Balls: The throwing of tennis or other "hard balls and Frisbees are prohibited. Squishy balls designed for pool usage are allowed.
- Rafts and flotation devices are prohibited. Noodles and flotation devices designed for young children unable to swim are permitted.

Children

- Parents/Guardians must insure that infants and children using the pools do not have a diarrheal illness.
- Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied at all times by an adult (18 years of age or older). Children ages 12-17 years of age do not qualify as an adult, and may swim unaccompanied but may not supervise younger children.
- Non-potty trained children must wear plastic, water-tight pants in addition to swim diapers. All children must be taken to the restroom to "potty". Changing diapers in the pool area is a violation of the Health Code.
- Children requiring flotation devices to assist in swimming are not allowed in the deep end of the pool unless accompanied by an adult. Lifeguards may exclude anyone from the deep water who has not demonstrated sufficient ability to swim.
- The baby pool is not monitored by lifeguards. Children in the baby pool are the responsibility of the parent or guardian. Children over the age of 5 are not permitted in the baby pool.

Contamination

Any Homeowner found contaminating the pool is subject to a fine and/or suspension of amenity privileges.

- Each individual should shower and rinse thoroughly before using the pools.
- No Food or Drink are allowed within 5 feet of the pool.
- Bathers with open wounds, skin conditions or any communicable condition are not allowed.
- There is to be no spitting, "spouting", or blowing of noses in the pool.

Diving

No diving from the side of the pool is allowed.

Glass and Sharp Objects

There are to be no glass containers, sharp objects, or other hazardous materials in the pool area.

Gates

Pool gates must remain closed and locked at all times. Gates must not be propped open, and gates should not be opened for other homeowners or guests without proper identification.

Guest Policy

Each household (unit) may bring up to five (5) accompanied guests at any one time. Unaccompanied guests are not permitted.

Gum

No gum is allowed in the pool area.

Hours of Operation

The hours of operation are noted above, anyone in the pool area after pool hours will be considered to be trespassing and the police will be notified.

Lifeguards

- No one should engage any lifeguard in unnecessary conversation
- Climbing or diving from lifeguard stands is prohibited

Loitering

Loitering will not be permitted on the pool grounds.

Pets and Service Animals

No pets are allowed in the recreational facilities. Service animals are allowed.

Pool Parties / Reservations

Usage of all areas of the pool is on a "first come, first served basis. Reservations for parties must be made through the HOA Board. Parties may be required to hire additional lifeguards at the expense of the sponsoring homeowner, when/if approved by the Board. All requests for pool parties should be made through the HOA management company.

Profanity

Absolutely no profanity of any kind will be permitted.

Mechanical and Storage Areas

Employees and designated agents of the Association are the only persons allowed access to the guard room, storage closets, mechanical and pump rooms, and attic.

Radios

Radio volume shall be kept at a level that does not disturb others.

Running

Running in the pool area is prohibited.

Smoking, Tobacco and Controlled Substances

- No smoking, use of e-cigarettes, vaping, or use of any tobacco product is permitted in the pool area.
- Controlled substances are prohibited
- Anyone appearing intoxicated from the influence of alcohol or narcotics or will be denied admission

Swimming Lessons

All private and group swim lessons are to be given by HOA approved vendors only.

Swim at Own Risk

Use of the pool is allowed on a SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK basis. The Association is not responsible for accidents or injury as a result of pool usage by homeowners or their invited guests.

Trash

It is the homeowner's responsibility to dispose of or remove any trash from the pool area that they created.

Weather

- Thunder: Everyone out of the pool for 15 minutes from the last time thunder is heard.
- Lightning: Everyone out of the pools for 30 minutes from the last time lightning was seen.
- Rain: Everyone out of the pools if the bottom of the pools cannot be seen clearly.
